How to register

1). Please complete a registration form with the following information:

- name
- date of birth
- age group (check for year born, then circle Group X,A,B,C,D or E)
- Tick events to enter (check Events List for each night and enter Event Number.)
- Swimmers signature **and** parent signature
- Please volunteer to help - we need volunteers to help run the Championships

Age groups shall be as follows:

Group X Under 11 Swimmers born in 1998 or later

Group A Under 13 Swimmers born 1996/97

Group B Under 15 Swimmers born 1994/95

Group C Under 17 Swimmers born 1992/93

Group D Under 19 Swimmers born 1990/91

Group E 19 years + born 1989 or earlier

2). Please return the registration form together with **£3** fee (cheques made payable to Beacon Swimming Club) per swimmer to Carol Boddy by **Monday 6th Oct 2008**, at the latest. No registration forms will be accepted without **£3** entry fee.

3). Remember that the championships are run over 2 different nights, with different events on each night.

4). Please keep a record of races entered as no reminders will be sent.

6). Please make sure you have read all the rules associated with this Championship.

Rules

The Championships are open to all members of the club provided:

- i) full membership has been paid.
 - ii) they have not competed in championships of another club in the same discipline this year, as stated in the constitution.
 - iii) if a member swims at any type of individual County event they must represent Beacon Swimming Club to be eligible to enter our Club Championships. Swimmers who do not represent Beacon Swimming Club at County events may swim but for time only.
1. The placing of swimmers will be decided by times, and the **Judges decisions are final**.
 2. There will be a one-start rule in accordance with ASA rules. In the event of a false start the swimmer may still swim, but for time only.
 3. Swimmers may be asked to remain in the pool whilst the next event starts.
 4. The championships are run according to ASA regulations which means swimmers may be disqualified for incorrect techniques, turns, etc., and the **Judges decisions are final**.
 5. The referee may decide to combine heats in order to reduce the overall number of starts. However medals will be awarded for each age group. Presentations may be made on a separate night with medals for 1st 2nd and 3rd places and ribbons for 4th, 5th and 6th places.

Beacon Swimming Club operates a points system for all the Championship events. Swimmers are awarded points for their performance over these events with trophies awarded at the Autumn AGM for those swimmers with the highest points in each age group.
